On Thursday, April 29th (the evening before the opening day of the 2010 AERA meeting) and Friday, April 30th (the opening morning of the AERA meeting), a group of historians of education will hold a mentoring seminar for graduate students and junior faculty members.

On Thursday evening, a panel discussion entitled "**Breaking Grounds, Crossing Borders: History and Education at the Cutting Edge**" will feature prominent senior scholars of history and education. On Friday morning, participants will engage in roundtable discussions that will address topics, such as navigating institutions, personal well-being, research (publication and funding), and teaching.

ALL junior faculty members and graduate students who are members of AERA Division F are encouraged to apply. Priority will be given to junior faculty within 4 years of degree completion and to graduate students who have completed their course work.

AERA will reimburse attendees for Thursday night's lodging. Dinner is provided for Thursday, and breakfast for Friday.
