



## Summary of AERA Journal Operations, 2009

The American Educational Research Association publishes five peer-reviewed journals and the peer-reviewed annual *Review of Research in Education (RRE)*, together covering a range of topics in education research. Editors serve fixed terms and report their activities twice a year to the Publications Committee. Journals are currently published on behalf of AERA by Sage Publications both in print and online. AERA members receive *Educational Researcher* and one other journal of their choice as benefits of membership; members may also subscribe to other AERA journals at a discounted cost. The table below summarizes 2009 publishing activities in AERA for the five open-submission journals.
