



AERA SIG Membership and Financial Tools

AERA Special Interest Group (SIG) officers have the ability to access and download membership and financial data pertaining to their SIG. These data include current, past, and lapsed membership lists, as well as listings of current SIG officers and SIG financial statements.

To access the SIG officer membership and financial tools:

1. Login at www.aera.net (click LOGIN at the top of the page)
2. Click on MY AERA at the top of the page
3. Click on MEMBER RESOURCES in the menu on the left side of the page
4. Click on SPECIAL INTEREST GROUP TOOLS
5. From this webpage, you can download membership lists and financial statements by selecting from the list of options below the SIG name.

Membership lists are updated daily, and financial reports are updated monthly. When you generate a list of SIG members, the member's AERA membership type will be listed, along with their name and other information. Please see below for information regarding the different AERA membership types.

AERA Membership Types

Voting Members:

Note: Voting Members can participate in all AERA elections and are eligible to serve as candidates for elected positions.

Regular (MA): Eligibility requires satisfactory evidence of active interest in education research as well as professional training to at least the master's degree level or equivalent.
\$215/calendar year.

Regular-Early Career (STEC): A one-year reduced membership fee for those who were Graduate Student members in immediate prior year and have obtained their doctoral degree.
\$115/calendar year

Retired (RET): Eligibility requires satisfactory evidence of active interest in education research as well as professional training to at least the master's degree level or equivalent, have reached age 65, retired from primary professional employment, and not otherwise engaged in paid full time work or its equivalent. \$115/calendar year.

Graduate Student (ST): Any graduate student may be granted graduate student member status with the endorsement of a voting member who is a faculty member at the student's university. Graduate students who are employed full time are not eligible. Graduate student membership is limited to seven years. \$65/calendar year.

Cohort Student (STC): Institutions that participate in the AERA Doctoral Student Cohort Program collaborate with AERA to allow full time students, as defined by the institution, in the doctoral program to join AERA with reduced dues of \$29 instead of the regular student dues of \$65, giving students the opportunity to experience AERA membership. This is a one-time introductory program to AERA.

Non-Voting Affiliate Members:

Note: Non-Voting Affiliate Members cannot participate in any AERA elections and are ineligible to serve as candidates for elected positions.

Affiliate (AS): Persons interested in education research who subscribe to the aims of the Association but who are not eligible for or do not seek to be Regular Members may become affiliates. No endorsement is needed. \$215/calendar year.

Student Affiliate (SA): Any non-graduate student may be granted student affiliate status with the endorsement of a voting member who is a faculty member at the student's college or university. Students who are employed full time are not eligible. Student membership is limited to five years. \$40/calendar year.

International Affiliate (IA): Citizens of countries other than the United States who are interested in education research are eligible to join this category. \$165/calendar year. An international affiliate who is qualified to become a voting member may change membership to the Regular Member category at any time.

International Affiliate – Low Income Countries (IAL): Citizens of countries other than the United States who are interested in education research and are from countries defined by the World Bank as Low Income Economies are eligible to join this category. \$85/calendar year.
